1. Le Serin White, Cotes de Gascogne, France	£4.75	£17.95
Deliciously crisp and fruity with acacia flower aromas, green apple hints and a ripe gooseberry finish, well rounded and extremely quaffable.		
Crisp & Dry		
2. Principato Pinot Grigio, Lombardia, Italy	£4.85	£18.95
Less sharp and more rounded than the Kiwi Sav Blanc.		
3. Sauvignon Blanc, Pato Torrente, Valle Central, Chile	£4.85	£18.95
Zesty lime, juicy melon and ripe tropical fruit flavours. Lively, with good intensity and a well-balanced rounded palate.		
4. Domaine du Pré Semelé Sancerre, France		£37.95
Mouth wateringly fresh Sauvignon Blanc from the grape's ancestral home. A wine that won't disappoint.		
5. Muscadet, Drouet Frères, Loire, France		£22.75
Pretty floral-tinged apple fruit, a little lemon citrus and hints of softer white fruits. Crisp, fresh and delicate, a bit of a classic for all manner of seafood.		
6. Domaine de la Motte Petit Chablis, France		£34.95
There's nothing little about this Chablis. La Motte have crafted an intense and approachable Chablis that belies its name.		
Dry & Aromatic		
7. La Val Orballo Albarino, Rias Baixas, Spain	£6.60	£26.50
Orballo is what the Galicians call 'fine rain' - it turns out North West Spain is as wet as North Wales. The wine itself is full of peachy freshness - delicious.		
8. L'Ormarine Duc de Morny Picpoul de Pinet, France		£24.50
Picpoul translates as lip-stinger which lets you know how this will taste. Vibrant with crunchy and refreshing fruit.		
9. Domaine Mas Bahourat 'La Petite Parcelle' de Viognier, Gard, France	£6.15	£23.95
An intense aromatic Viognier produced from a tiny plot in the South of France. Classic notes of apricot and blossom jump out the glass.		
10. Villa Wolf Pinot Gris, Pfalz, Germany		£27.95
Made by renowned Alsace producer Dr Ernst Loosen. A stunning, off-dry and fruity white wine with a delicate acidity and honeyed notes on the finish.		
Clean & Rounded		
11. The Cloud Factory Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand	£6.15	£23.75
This delivers exactly what you'd expect from a Marlborough Sauvignon - need we say more?		
12. Walt Riesling, Pfalz, Germany		£24.25
An elegant, off-dry, fruity Riesling. Lovely peach and stone fruits with a whiff of elderflower and refreshing lime-grapefruit zippiness. Top draw Riesling.		
13. Baboon Rock Unwooded Chardonnay, La Petite Ferme, Robertson, South Africa		£27.00
If unoaked chardonnay is your thing, this will not disappoint. Lime and honey, then melon and orange (fruit and flowers); brilliant concentration with some honeyed richness too. Clean as a whistle, and great bang for your buck!		

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| 14. Pouilly-Fuissé cuvée Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Guerrin & Fils, Burgundy, France | £39.95 |
| 40+ year old chardonnay vines grown on limestone soils give impressive depth and intensity, and no little mineralité, supported by judicious oak: sweet white flowers, succulent peach fruit and more exotic notes besides. | |
| 15. Laughing Giraffe Chenin Blanc, South Africa | £5.15 £19.75 |
| Aromas of citrus tropical fruit lychee and peach beautifully rounded with a clean off dry finish
Aromas of packed pear honeysuckle and orange blossom lead this expressive wine followed by a beautiful tropical peach undertone. | |
| 16. Gavi DOCG del Comune di Gavi, La Chiara, Tuscany, Italy | £29.95 |
| Immaculate, pure Cortese: fresh as a daisy and redolent of green apple, fruit blossom and honey.
Well-structured with good richness and super length of flavour. | |

Fuller Bodied

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| 17. Clos de l'Eglise Macon-Charnay, Beaujolais / Maconnais, France | £32.50 |
| An unoaked White Burgundy from a single plot of old vines – a truly elegant high-end Chardonnay from one of the top villages of Macon. | |
| 18. The Last Stand Chardonnay, Victoria, Australia | £5.85 £22.95 |
| Phenomenally good Aussie Chardonnay at this money. Unoaked, bright with white peaches, a citrus hit and that linear mineral finish. | |
| 19. Fiano, Carlomagno, Puglia IGP, Italy | £22.95 |
| Generous, aromatic style offering up notes of grapefruit, melon and banana. Nicely textured, plump and round with a lively sappy frame. | |
| 20. Finca don Mauro Torrontes, Mendoza, Argentina | £19.95 |
| Fragrant, juicy & bags of fruit. A nose of peach, apricot and honeysuckle moves to a dry palate with passion fruit, honeyed lemon and orchard fruits. Perfect with asian and spicy foods or great by itself. | |

| Light and fresh with just a hint of floral, lemony creaminess. | | |
| 23. Veuve Deloynes. Brut, France | | £39.95 |
| A smooth, dry palate with a light, floral, slightly creamy palate and lots of crisp citrus flavours. | | |
| 24. Veuve Clicquot | | £64.95 |
| For those occasions when only this Grande Marque with the yellow label will do. Crisp, fresh, full bodied and stunning. | | |
| 25. Rosè Vino Frizzante, Fabio Ceschin, Veneto, Italy NV | | £24.95 |
| Produced in Prosecco country but from the lesser-known Raboso grape. Pretty floral-tinged sweet berry fruit, fine mousse and a crisp savoury finish. | | |
| 26. Lallier Grand Rosé, France | | £55.00 |
| A boutique Champagne house sited in the same village as Bollinger. Lallier only use 'Grand Cru' fruit – the highest mark of quality in Champagne. This is a real treat. | | |

| The epitome of strawberries and cream in a glass. | | |
| 28. Terrazze della Luna Pinot Grigio Rosato, Trentino, Italy | £5.35 | £20.50 |
| Produced in a traditional method to extract the natural pinky bronze colour associated with Pinot Grigio – this is an elegant and dry rosé. | | |
| 29. Domaine de la Vielle Tour Rose, Cotes de Provence, France | | £24.95 |
| A very drinkable and perfectly pale pink, that screams Provence. | | |

30. **Monte Oton Garnacha, Campo de Borja, Spain** £4.75 £17.95
A dark, brambly and delicious red from one of the best producers in the region, Borsao in Northern Spain. Great on its own or with food.

Elegant, Easy & Soft

31. **Merlot, Ladera Verde, Valle Central, Chile** £4.95 £18.95
Medium-bodied, round and juicy, with ripe plum, cherry and raspberry fruit. A short time in oak gives hints of wood spice, toast, roasted coffee and vanilla.
32. **Vega del Rayo Rioja Tempranillo, Rioja, Spain** £5.15 £19.95
A modern and vibrant young wine from Rioja Alta. All those familiar delicate tannins of Tempranillo, with plums and cherries balanced with a savoury earthy note.
33. **Beaujolais, Jacques Charlet, France** £24.95
Red summer fruits, white flowers and a dash of pepper. Classic light-bodied Gamay, with juicy acidity and low levels of tannin.
34. **Chianti Colli Senesi DOCG, Geografico, Tuscany, Italy** £25.95
Unapologetically easy-going, with supple and rounded wine based on Sangiovese, from the hills around Siena: a mix of cherry fruit and fragrant dark flowers.
35. **Pinot Noir. Honu, Marlborough. New Zealand** £29.50
Strawberry leaf aromas leading into tantalising savoury, raspberry flavours and a blueberry finish. Great value Kiwi Pinot.

Smooth, Silky & Earthy

36. **Crozes-Hermitage 'Classique', Cave de Clairmont, Rhône, France** £37.00
Beautifully intense, perfumed Syrah full of peppery blackberry fruit, cassis, strawberry and violets. Silky and elegant, with great freshness and super concentration.
37. **Silver Myn Argentum, Stellenbosch, South Africa** £21.75
A powerful and rich blend of Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon - think Bordeaux but with plenty of New World fruit. Brilliant value.
38. **Château Montaguillon, Montagne-Saint-Emilion, Bordeaux, France** £35.95
Lovely rich nose of confit black fruits with some crunchy red fruit highlights. Plump and mouth-filling with a velvety feel to the tannins.
39. **Vallet Bourgogne Pinot Noir, France** £34.95
Made the old fashioned way, as it has for generations, from a small family concern in Beaune. Traditional wine making makes this old world Pinot Noir one for the purists.
40. **Rioja Reserva. Azabache, Bodegas Aldeanueva. Spain** £34.95
If you love your Rioja grown up, full, and ripe, this is a wine for you. With a blackberry bouquet, notes of vanilla and chocolate, and a warming finish.

Warm & Spicy

41. **La Ruchette Dorée Cotes du Rhone Villages, France** £24.95
A ripe, smooth and characterful red from the South Rhone, a lovely example of this Mediterranean classic.
42. **Kelly's Patch Shiraz, Australia** £4.10 £21.00
From a vineyard which occupies the homestead of the infamous Aussie bushranger Ned Kelly. This bright and spicy wine is as bold in flavour as Kelly. Plums, cassis & chocolate. Great with red meat or quaffed on its own.

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| 43. Bacca Nera. Negroamaro Primitivo, Salento, Italy | £6.25 £23.95 |
| A stunner from the heat of the heel of Italy. A lovely plummy character with soft, jammy tannins and an intense red fruit bouquet. | |
| 44. Cline 'Old Vine' Lodi Zinfandel, Lodi, California, USA | £27.95 |
| Classic and classy Californian Zin. French oak provides just the right amount of toasty vanilla character whilst the overtly ripe and luscious Zinfandel fruit makes this big and bold. | |

Big, Powerful & Intense

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| 45. The Black Craft Shiraz, Barossa Valley, South Australia | £28.50 |
| This is a proper Barossa Shiraz. Rich, chocolatey with heaps of fruit but no hint of jam or sweetness – savoury, grown up and serious. | |
| 46. Chateauneuf du Pape. Victor Berard, Rhone Valley. France | £49.95 |
| A full bodied, heavy style, deep garnet in colour with ripe berries and spice on the finish. A wine worthy of pushing the boat out. | |
| 47. Pinna Fidelis Roble Ribera del Duero, Duero, Spain | £28.50 |
| We like to think of Ribera del Duero as a bolder, richer and punchier Rioja – a particular favourite of ours. | |
| 48. Malbec 'Selection Belles Vignes', Martinfort, IGP Pays d'Oc, France | £5.85 £22.95 |
| Medium-bodied, soft and juicy, packed with ripe black cherry, blackberry and herby notes. Has great immediate appeal and a really smooth, lush palate. | |
| 49. Victoria Park Cabernet Sauvignon - Australia | £6.45 £24.95 |
| Silky smooth, deep purple colour, and layers of black berries and dark chocolate, and soft tannins, exactly what you'd expect from a cabernet sauvignon from down under. | |
| 50. Botter Amarone – Italy | £45.00 |
| Not for the feint hearted. This powerful wine is made using partially dried grapes from the Venetian hillsides which gives the wine its intense richness and full bodied flavour of prunes, chocolate and spice. | |

Dessert Wine

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| 51. St Helene Sauternes, Bordeaux, France (1/2 bottle) | 125ml Bottle

| This fantastic sweet wine comes from the heart of Bordeaux. This wonderfully sweet, golden nectar is produced from a blend of Semillon and Sauvignon Blanc. | |
